

COOKIES POLICY

We (Ficosota Ltd., a limited liability company, registered in the Commercial Register with the Registry Agency of the Republic of Bulgaria, with unique identification code (UIC) 837055835, with registered office and registered office: Bulgaria, Shumen, Madara Blvd. № 48) we use cookies or similar tools on our website to improve its presentation while you use it. This policy explains how we do this and what your choices are about cookies.

WHAT ARE BISCUITS?

An HTTP cookie, commonly called simply a cookie, is a packet of information sent from a web server to an Internet browser, such as Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge, Safari, Opera, Mozilla Firefox, Chrome, or the like, and then returned from the browser each time it accesses that server.

There are two main types of cookies - permanent and temporary, or even called session cookies. Permanent cookies are stored as a file on your computer or mobile device for an extended period of time. A cookie stays in your device for use in the next session, and it can be deleted in the meantime. If you use more than one browser, each one has a separate cookie storage area. Temporary (session) cookies are temporarily inserted into your device when you visit our website, but disappear when you close the page, which means that they are not permanently stored on your device. Cookies do not save information about a person, but for a combination of device and internet browser. Therefore, one person who uses multiple browsers and / or devices has a separate set of cookies for each device and browser combination. Cookies, on the other hand, do not differentiate between multiple users sharing the same device and browser, unless they have different profiles.

Most companies use cookies on their websites to improve usability.

WHAT ARE WE USING COOKIES FOR?

Cookies have many different functions. For example, they help us analyze how well our website is performing so that we can improve it.

In this sense, we may use non-personalized information from session cookies for statistical purposes as follows:

- Identifying which are the most popular parts of our site;
- Monitoring the use of our site (frequency and time);
- Providing anonymous information to third parties so that more relevant and interesting information is directed to you;

- Administrating our site, including for troubleshooting and fixing technical issues;
- Monitor users' interest in a particular product or certain sections or functionalities of the page;
- Determining how often you and other users visit our site and the interest you have in our products;
- Complete improvement of your interaction with our website.

WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?

When using our site, we may collect the following types of cookies:

- **Mandatory cookies**

These cookies are strictly necessary for the website to fulfill its functions. These cookies are used to:

- authenticate users when they use the Website so that we can present our products to them;
- we may fulfill our conditions of use of the Website; and we
- maintain the security of this page.

- **Session cookies**

We use session cookies, for example, for the purpose of providing more personalized suggestions; so we can recognize you when you return to our site and more.

Cookies cannot harm your files and do not affect your device or your work in any way.

- **Third-party cookies**

Third-party cookies are provided by other organizations that we use to provide us with various services, such as service providers, including marketing service providers, to provide personalized content, advertising and traffic analysis. This happens through cookies and other web beacons or pixel tagging. Pixel tags and other internet tags are small graphical images located on separate parts of our site and allow us to understand if you have taken any action.

In these cases, shared cookies are managed by the respective third parties and are not controlled by us. Listed below are the third party services we use, some of which can be turned off using the general settings of your browser. For others, you should visit their respective websites and follow the instructions given to them. They all use different cookies.
